Nevada.

At minimum, these laws are requiring free menstrual care products in school restrooms. Some extend the requirement to restrooms in all public spaces. Entire countries are changing their laws as well. In 2020, Scotland became the first country in the world to make period products free for all. It's all part of a growing trend to make access to menstrual care products a priority.

What Nevada's law says:

Each school district must ensure that menstrual products are provided at no cost to pupils in the bathrooms of each middle school, junior high school and high school in the school district or charter school.


