

Colorado HB 24-1164 Supporting Students: Expanding Menstrual Hygiene in Colorado Schools

- 1. Requires local education providers to provide free menstrual products in at least half of applicable school bathrooms that are accessible to students.
- 2. Qualifications: All local education providers in Colorado with grades six through twelve
- 3. **Timeline:** Beginning July 1, 2025





This bill was proposed by legislatures to ensure that period products are readily available in school bathrooms for students in sixth through twelfth grade. It aims to strengthen the existing "Menstrual Hygiene Products Accessibility Grant Program" by extending its support to more Colorado school districts, enabling them to cater to the needs of their students.
