



Kansas HB 2727

1. House Bill 2727 requires public schools and public postsecondary education institutions to make menstrual products available at no cost.
 - A. Each school of a school district or charter school in this state with grades five and below shall make menstrual products available, at no cost to students, in at least one neutral location that is easily accessible to all students.
 - B. Menstrual products shall be made available in all females, gender-neutral, and standalone handicapped restrooms accessed by students in any of the grades six through 12.



2. **Timeline:** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
