

New York S.5913A Ensuring equal access to menstrual hygiene.

- 1. Requires menstrual products to be provided for free in all elementary and secondary public schools and non-public schools in the state.
- 2. Qualifications: All elementary and secondary public and non-public schools in the state serving grades 6-12.
- 3. Timeline: This takes effect in the first week of July next succeeding the date on which it shall have become law.
- 4. Signed into law November 17, 2023





The public health law has been amended to include a new section 267, which stipulates that all non-public schools in the state serving grades six through twelve must ensure the availability of menstrual hygiene products.
