

## Pennsylvania HB 799

- 1. Each school serving any student grades six through twelve shall make menstrual hygiene products available at no cost in each bathroom in the school building.
- 2. Qualifications: Public and charter schools with grades 6-12.
- 3. Timeline: This act shall take immediately or 120 days after it gets signed into law.





The legislation proposed amends the act that was passed on March 10, 1949, which is related to the public school system and contains provisions that also affect private and parochial schools. It intends to revise, consolidate, and update the laws governing school health services, with a particular emphasis on menstrual health hygiene.
