

Pennsylvania HB 900 **Access to Period Products in Correctional Facilities**

- 1. All incarcerated individuals and detainees who are menstruating each month shall be provided with menstrual hygiene products at no cost.
- 2. Qualifications: Incarcerated people who menstruate in a prison each month
- 3. Timeline: This act shall take effect in 180 days
- 4. Signed into law December 14, 2023





The proposed bill mandates that incarcerated individuals have access to menstrual care products without any financial burden. They will be able to select from a minimum of two sizes of tampons.
