

Tennessee HB 2207

- 1. House Bill 2207 requires each LEA and public charter school shall provide feminine hygiene products, at no charge.
- A. The Department of Education may develop policies and guide LEAs and public charter schools to assist local boards of education and public charter school governing bodies in complying.
- B. The Department of Education may only expend any money deposited into the menstrual hygiene products accessibility account to purchase feminine hygiene products for eligible schools to assist in complying with the requirements.



2. Timeline: This act takes effect July 1, 2024.
